Dr. Andrew Gettelman is a senior scientist at the National Center for Atmospheric Research, specializing in global climate modeling. His work concerns development and analysis of global model simulations of the climate system with a focus on development of physical parameterizations of clouds in global climate models, and the physics and chemistry of the Upper Troposphere and Lower Stratosphere. Dr. Gettelman is a member of the atmospheric model development team and co-chair of the Whole Atmosphere Working Group of the Community Earth System Model. Dr. Gettelman is a contributing author and reviewer for international scientific assessments of climate change and ozone depletion. Dr. Gettelman has a PhD in Atmospheric Sciences from the University of Washington and a Bachelors of Science in Civil Engineering from Princeton University.
