Luc Corbeil has been involved in HPC for more than 20 years in government and academic organizations. Currently Senior Advisor within the Supercomputing Directorate at Shared Services Canada, he is responsible for coordinating delivery of supercomputing services to Canadian government departments and agencies. He coordinates the deployment of a complete overhaul of the high-performance computing infrastructure.

He began his career in model optimization and system administration prior to becoming a manager in 2005. He led the deployment of several HPC systems and managed mission-critical operations for Environment Canada. At the Swiss National Supercomputing Centre, he was in charge of a team supporting systems for MeteoSwiss, ETHZ and the BlueBrain project between 2012 and 2014.
